Speaker Biographies

Orlando Night Club Shooting

Deputy Chief Orlando Rolón



November 8, 1992, Deputy Chief Orlando Rolón was hired by the Orlando Police Department. Before his first promotion, he served as an officer in East Patrol, the Community Oriented Policing Division, and as a detective of the Violent Crimes Section of the Criminal Investigations Division.

Deputy Chief Rolón is assigned as Patrol Services Bureau Commander with nearly 400 members under his command. He is a graduate of the Southern Police Institute Command Officer Development Course, Leadership Orlando Class #89, and the FBI National Academy Session 263.

Deputy Chief Rolón was a Commander during the Pulse incident and coordinated many of the resources allocated during the incident and recovery efforts.

Assistant Chief Paul Plaugher



Assistant Chief Paul Plaugher has served the Orlando Fire Department with 20 years of experience. He has a Master's Degree in Emergency Services Management from Columbia Southern University. During the time of the Pulse incident, he was Shift Commander.

Gary Parrish, MD, FACEP



Dr. Parrish is the Medical Director of the Emergency Department at Orlando Health/Orlando Regional Medical Center in Orlando, Florida. He also serves as the clinical chairman of the Department of Emergency Medicine at ORMC and is a faculty member in their Emergency Medicine residency training program. He attended medical school at the University of Alabama in Birmingham and residency at Geisinger Medical Center in Danville, Pennsylvania. He is a clinical assistant professor at the University of Florida School of Medicine and is currently a board-certified emergency physician in his 30th year of clinical practice. He was on duty in the Emergency Department at ORMC on June 12, 2016, and cared for victims of the Pulse Nightclub shooting tragedy.
