We, Arizona providers, provider associations, professional healthcare licensure associations, Arizona's Medicaid health plans, and the business community proudly endorse Arizona's participation in the Rural Health Transformation Program.

Since August, the State of Arizona has been actively engaged with the healthcare community and business leaders, including and especially rural healthcare providers, in seeking input and feedback regarding the current challenges we face in providing healthcare in rural Arizona.

The needs in our rural communities have never been greater. We have worked collaboratively with the State of Arizona, through the Office of Governor Katie Hobbs, Arizona's Medicaid agency (the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System or AHCCCS), the Arizona Department of Health Services, and the Office of Economic Opportunity as well as with members of Arizona's business community who share our commitment to strengthening the state's economic and healthcare infrastructure.
